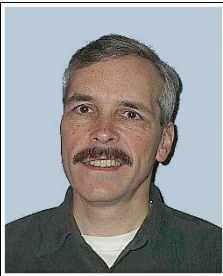

The School

Northwest College of The Bible conducts its classes in the facilities of *Central Christian Church* in Portland, Oregon. It is a cooperative effort of evangelists, elders and teachers in the northwest working together under the oversight of the elders of *Central Christian Church*.

We hope that NCB can play an important role in helping you achieve your ministry goals. If you are planning to enter a full-time ministry in a local church, prepare for overseas mission work, or better equip yourself for volunteer work in the Kingdom of God, NCB will give you the tools necessary to make your dreams a reality.

The Purpose

The purpose of NCB is to equip Christians for ministry in their local congregations, prepare Christians for missionary work in the world, and help Christians develop the skills and character traits necessary for leadership in the Lord's Church. This is accomplished through the cooperative efforts of the evangelists, pastors and teachers of the local congregations.

All of the teachers at NCB hold academic degrees in ministry, missions, sacred literature or theology. All of the teachers at NCB have been involved in several years of successful ministry. And all of the teachers are ordained active leaders in a local Christian Church or Church of Christ.

Accreditation and Degrees

Northwest College of the Bible offers three degrees: a two year Associate of Sacred Literature, a four year Bachelor of Sacred Literature, and a five year Bachelor of Theology. We have been successfully equipping young men and women for service in the Lord's church since 1952. Our high academic level is comparable to other Bible Colleges, and most secular colleges and universities accept our credits for continuing education. Many of today's godly and successful preachers have come from this school.

Tuition

You can attend NCB tuition free!

Tuition is lightened substantially by the "supporting congregations" of the area. Students who place their fellowship with one of the supporting churches can attend NCB tuition free. These students must place their fellowship and their tithe with the supporting church, be active in the work of that congregation, and maintain at least a "C" grade average in school.

Orientation Day

Orientation is Wednesday, September 5 at 8:00 AM.

The first hour of this day is devoted to getting acquainted with the faculty, the school, and fellow students. All students are required to attend this function.

Registration

Course Descriptions

OT 304 Old Testament Prophets

Instructor: Mike Kennedy
8 credit hours

The prophets from Isaiah to Malachi tell a three-part story of the pride and sin of Israel, their destruction and captivity, and the return and rebuilding of the New Jerusalem. These books also describe the coming of the Messiah and the Church He would establish.

NT 401 Romans

Instructor: Dave Adams
4 credit hours

This is a single semester course in which students will engage in an examination of the book of Romans. This is one of the most important books in the New Testament. The basic doctrines of Christianity are set forth here, as well as rich teaching for everyday Christian living.

TH 107 New Testament Church

Instructor: Dave Brink
4 credit hours

This single semester class is an in-depth study of what the Bible teaches about the church. Students will develop a thorough understanding of God's purpose and design for His church.

NT 102 Life of Christ

Instructor: Charles Dailey
8 credit hours

This is an examination of the events and teachings of the life of Christ from His birth to His resurrection and ascension. This class will be offered online at <http://ncbible.info/>.

MN 401 Congregational Development

Instructor: Dave Brink
4 credit hours

This course contains practical instructions for church leaders in the 21st century. There is a strong emphasis on strategies for effective discipleship as well as discussions about improving congregational worship, church money management, congregational administration, and developing leadership in the church.

MN 203 World Missions

Instructor: Charles Dailey
4 credit hours

This class examines the methods and strategies for successful missionary work in the world today. This class will be offered online at <http://ncbible.info/>.
